I, the undersigned, certify that the animals described above meet the following requirements:

- (a) on....., being within 48 hours of export, I examined the said animals and found them to be free of external parasites and from clinical signs of notifiable infectious or contagious diseases;
- (b) the said animals were subjected to tests for the following diseases within 30 days prior to export, with negative results:
 - i) tuberculosis: the intradermal comparative test using avian and bovine PPD tuberculins;
 - ii) brucellosis: the *complement fixation test (CFT) OR *enzyme linked immunoassay (ELISA) OR *buffered antigen test OR *serum agglutination test (SAT);
 - iii) caprine arthritis-encephalitis (CAE): the *agar gel immunodiffusion test (AGIDT) OR *ELISA;
- (c) as far as can be determined, the animals have not been on a holding/s subjected to official restrictions as a result of confirmation of a notifiable infectious or contagious disease during the 60 days prior to export.
