IV. Health Information

I, the undersigned, certify that the animals described above meet the following requirements:

- a) the said animals were born and have been raised in the United Kingdom and a written declaration has been received from the exporter/agent stating that they will be shipped directly to St Lucia;
- b) the United Kingdom has been free of Foot and Mouth Disease, Rinderpest and Pestes des Petits Ruminants for at least five (5) years prior to the date of exportation;
- c) on, being within 24 hours of loading, I examined the said animals and found them to be physically sound, in good health and free of clinical symptoms of Rabies, Contagious Caprine Pleuropneumonia, Caprine Arthritis Encephalitis (CAE) or any notifiable infectious or contagious disease;
- d) on, being within ten (10) days immediately prior to export, the said animals were subjected to a comparative intradermal tuberculin test using avian and bovine purified protein derivative (PPD) tuberculins, with negative results according to the Department's standard interpretation;
- f) with regard to scrapie, the said animals:
 - (i) originate from a country which adopts the recommended measures set out in the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code for the control and eradication of scrapie;
 - (ii) were born and raised on holdings free from scrapie as defined in the corresponding Chapter of the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code;
 - (iii) after due enquiry and as far as can be determined, are not the progeny of a parent or siblings of animals with confirmed scrapie;
- * g) goats only: on, being within 30 days prior to
 export, samples were taken from the said animals and subjected to *
 either an agar gel immunodiffusion test (AGIDT) or * or an enzymelinked immunosorbent assay (ELISA) for Caprine Arthritis Encephalitis
 (CAE), with negative results;
