a) the donor animals have been resident for at least 40 days on an approved semen collection centre, and all the pigs on the centre were free from clinical signs of TGE during the 12 months prior to the collection of semen for export to Northern Ireland;

*b) **For fresh semen:**

*i the donor animals were subjected to a diagnostic test for TGE during the 30 days prior to collection of semen for export with negative results in each and every case:

*ii all animals in the approved semen collection centre have been subjected to a diagnostic test for TGE prior to their entry onto the centre and
 a) routinely while resident on the centre and/or
 b) prior to their exit from the centre, with negative results;

*c) **For frozen semen:**

the donor animals were subjected to a diagnostic test for TGE at least 14 days after collection of semen for export with negative results in each and every case:
