- (b) is derived from healthy animals that were slaughtered and the meat processed, packaged and stored in officially approved meat establishments authorised by the Government of the United Kingdom, and inspected and passed for export by an Official Veterinarian of the competent authority of the exporting country;
- (c) has not been found to be contaminated by infectious and zoonotic diseases and does not exceed acceptable levels set by the Philippine standards and/or international standards;
- (d) does not contain residues of antibiotics, pesticides, hormones, heavy metals, similar substances and radioactivity that may pose public health and environmental hazards;

- (e) bears the official inspection mark on the primary, secondary and/or shipping packaging showing proof that the meat has been certified as inspected and passed by the competent authority in compliance with the national food regulations of the exporting country;
- (f) will be transported in accordance with current hygiene regulations, ensuring the wholesomeness and condition of the products, elimination of the possibility of introduction of contaminants and pests and ensuring maintenance of temperature control. The refrigerated containers have passed sanitary inspection and are fit for loading.
