 $^{^{1}}$ a copy of the original health certificate (and any attachments) certifying that the pig meat/meat product is eligible for export to Australia, that has been certified and officially endorsed by the official veterinarian responsible for oversight of receipt of the pig meat/meat product at the establishment that received and stored the pig meat/meat product on arrival in Great Britain, must be attached and accompany the consignment to Australia. The original health certificate and any attachments must be retained for 7 years from the date of arrival and made available to the Australian Government Department of Agriculture and Water Resources on request.
