I, the undersigned, certify that the consignment described at I above meets the following requirements:

- (a) The United Kingdom is recognised by the Office International des Epizooties (OIE) as a country free from foot and mouth disease (without vaccination), classical swine fever, African swine fever and Teschen disease;
- (b) the meat was derived from animals which originated in the territory of the United Kingdom and/or the European Union (EU);
- (c) the products were manufactured in accordance with legislation currently in force in the United Kingdom and/or the EU Member State of origin and is safe and fit for human consumption;
- (d) the animals from which the products were derived have been subjected to both ante and post-mortem inspection under veterinary supervision in a slaughterhouse approved by the competent authority of the country of origin, and were found to be free from signs of any OIE list A disease to which the species is susceptible;
- (e) the products have been handled, processed, packaged and stored in a hygienic manner at establishments that have been subjected to inspections by the competent authority of the country/countries of origin and implement a food safety management system based on HACCP principles or an equivalent system, so as to prevent contamination with agents known to cause infectious diseases of domestic animals and humans;
- (f) the transport vehicles or containers and the loading conditions of this consignment meet the hygiene requirements laid down in legislation currently in force in the United Kingdom.
