IV. Health information

I, the undersigned, certify that the animals described above meet the following requirements:

- (a) the United Kingdom is free from foot and mouth disease, African swine fever, classical swine fever, brucellosis (Brucella suis), swine vesicular disease and rinderpest in accordance with the World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE) Terrestrial Animal Health Code. Vaccination against these diseases is not permitted in the United Kingdom;
- (b) Nipah virus infection has not been recorded in pigs in the United Kingdom during the past two (2) years;
- (c) the premises of origin are not situated in an area subject to official restrictions due to a notifiable disease to which pigs are susceptible;
- (d) there has been no clinical or microbiological evidence of tuberculosis or brucellosis at the premises of origin during the past twelve (12) months;
- (e) there has been no clinical evidence of the following diseases at the premises of origin:
 - (i) leptospirosis or progressive atrophic rhinitis during the past twelve (12) months;
 - (ii) porcine reproductive and respiratory syndrome (PRRS) during the past six (6) months;
 - (iii) transmissible gastroenteritis (TGE) during the past six (6)
 months;
- (f) during the six (6) months immediately prior to the date of export, the herd(s) of origin has/have been free from a pattern of mortality and clinical signs consistent with an outbreak of postweaning multisystemic wasting syndrome (PMWS) or porcine dermatitis and nephropathy syndrome (PDNS);
- (g) the animals for export have been kept isolated under official veterinary supervision for a minimum of thirty (30) days prior to embarkation in an approved export quarantine facility which was cleansed and disinfected with an approved disinfectant prior to use;
- (h) with regard to PRRS, on........................ (date), being within thirty (30) days prior to the intended date of export and during the pre-export isolation period, blood samples were taken from the animals and sent to a laboratory officially approved by the competent veterinary authority where they were subjected to **either:**
