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### IV Health Information

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, certify that:

(a) the products described above were derived from cattle that were born and raised in \*England<sup>1</sup>, \*Wales<sup>1</sup>, \*Scotland<sup>2</sup>, \*Northern Ireland<sup>2</sup> and/or \*the Republic of Ireland<sup>1</sup>;

#### With regard to Foot and Mouth disease (FMD):

(b) the exporting country and the country/zone of origin of the animals from which the meat is derived has/have been free from FMD for six (6) months immediately prior to the date of the slaughter of the animals **and** the date of issue of this certificate;

- (c) \*(i) the exporting country and the country/zone of origin of the animals from which the meat is derived is free of FMD without vaccination; **or**
- \*(ii) the exporting country and the country/zone of origin of the animals from which the meat is derived is free of FMD with vaccination; **and** the products described above for export to Singapore comprises only deboned cuts; **or**
- \*(iii) the exporting country and the country/zone of origin of the animals from which the meat is derived is an FMD-affected country/zone; **and** the products described above for export to Singapore have been subjected to heat treatment that is sufficient for inactivation of FMD virus in accordance with OIE guidelines.

**With regard to Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE):**

- (d)(1) **FOR MEAT DERIVED FROM CATTLE BORN AND RAISED IN A COUNTRY/ZONE WITH A CONTROLLED BSE RISK**

- \*(iii) retort processed meat products (e.g. canned meat) have been heat treated (sterilising process with sterilising value of not less than Fo3) to commercial sterility in hermetically sealed containers and are shelf stable at ambient temperatures;
- (e) the exporting country and the country/zone of origin of the animals from which the meat is derived has/have a reliable system of traceability in place;

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<sup>3</sup> Eligible beef cuts include skeletal muscle cuts and other parts of the carcass. Carcass is defined as the body of an animal after slaughter and dressing e.g. bones and marrow, connective tissue (tendon, ligament, cartilage, sinew) ear, fat, feet/trotter, head (including jowl meat), skin/rind, tail, trimmings, snout.

<sup>4</sup> Green offal - intestines (includes rectum, oesophagus and stomach).  
 Red offal - diaphragm, heart, kidneys, liver, tongue, spleen, trachea and larynx.

- (f) the products have not been derived from suspect or confirmed BSE cases, or suspect or confirmed progeny or cohorts of BSE cases, as described in the Terrestrial Animal Health Code;
- (g) the products have been derived from cattle that were not subjected to a stunning process with a device injecting compressed air or gas into the cranial cavity, or to a pithing process;
- (h) specified risk materials<sup>5</sup> (as defined by the Agri-Food and Veterinary Authority of Singapore (AVA) in controlled BSE risk and negligible BSE risk countries) have been cleanly removed from products for export to Singapore without contamination of the meat;

**Additional Statements:**

- (i) the products described above were prepared in an establishment accredited by the AVA and is audited regularly by the competent authority of the exporting country for compliance with conditions for import into Singapore;
- (j) the meat has been derived from animals which have passed ante-mortem and post-mortem inspection and found to be free from infectious and contagious diseases. Ante-mortem and post-mortem inspections have been carried out by veterinarians or meat inspectors under direct supervision of government veterinarians;
- (k) the animals from which the meat was derived were slaughtered and the meat processed, packed and stored in sanitary conditions under official veterinary supervision in establishments approved by the Director-General, Agri-Food and Veterinary Services for export to Singapore;
- (l) the meat described above has not been treated with chemical preservatives or other substances injurious to health;
- (m) the meat described above was inspected and found fit for human consumption. Every precaution has been taken to prevent contamination prior to export.
