IV. Health information

I, the undersigned, certify that the animals described above meet the following requirements:

- (a) The United Kingdom is recognised by the UK central competent authority as free from foot and mouth disease (FMD), classical swine fever (CSF) and African swine fever (ASF);
- (b) the pigs described above originated from an area or zone where no case of vesicular stomatitis has occurred in the 12 months prior to shipment;
- (c) the pigs described above were raised for at least 3 months prior to export or since birth in establishments which comply with the following requirements:
 - (i) no cases of brucellosis, enterovirus encephalomyelitis (Teschen/Talfan disease), tuberculosis (*Mycobacterium bovis*, *M. caprae* and *M. tuberculosis*), pseudorabies (Aujeszky's disease), swine vesicular disease (SVD), vesicular exanthema, porcine reproductive and respiratory syndrome (PRRS) and swine hemorrhagic septicaemia (pasteurellosis) have been confirmed in the previous year;
 - (ii) no cases of atrophic rhinitis, actinobacillus pleuropneumonia, transmissible gastroenteritis, leptospirosis, toxoplasmosis, swine influenza, swine erysipelas and Nipah virus encephalitis have been confirmed in the past 6 months;
- (d) the pigs described above are not vaccinated against FMD, CSF, pseudorabies, brucellosis, PRRS and ASF;
- (e) according to the report of the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH) or the recent epidemiological information, the following diseases have not occurred in the United Kingdom for more than five years prior to export: FMD, ASF, brucellosis (*Brucella abortus*, *B. melitensis*, and *B. suis*), SVD, pseudorabies (Aujeszky's disease), vesicular stomatitis, transmissible gastroenteritis (TGE) and porcine epidemic diarrhoea (PED);
- (f) before exportation, the pigs described above were detained in quarantine premises and under the supervision of veterinarians accredited by a competent authority of the United Kingdom for at least 14 days prior to export;

during the quarantine period, the pigs were examined and found to be in a healthy condition without any clinical signs and were subjected to the following tests with negative results:

(g) during the isolation period, including on (date), being within 24 hours of shipment, the animals were examined and found to be free from clinical evidence of any communicable disease and are fit to travel;

(h) a signed undertaking has been received from the owner / exporter stating that the following arrangements have been made regarding the transportation of the animals from the quarantine premises to their destination;

(i) the means of transport and transit comply with the WOAH Terrestrial Animal Health Code and the Live Animal Regulations of the International Air Transport Association (IATA).

(ii) the animals will be transported in containers/vehicles previously cleansed and disinfected with an approved disinfectant;

(iii) the animals will not transit through seaports/airports in countries or zones not recognised as being free from FMD, CSF and ASF;

(iv) no additional feed, straw and forage, bedding or other susceptible animals will to be loaded en route to the destination.

V. Validity of Certificate

This health certificate is valid for 10 days from the date of signature. If the consignment is transported from the country of origin by sea, the period of validity is extended by the duration of the voyage
